

Radical Womxn's Dance Party: Against Immigration Detention

Nov 29-Dec 2

This week's exhibition at OUTPUT sees Radical Womxn's Dance Party take over the gallery. RWDP are a collective based in Liverpool, organising events that articulate and protest womxn's struggles within wider anti-capitalist resistance movements. This series of talks and workshops concerns the conditions faced by those detained in 'Immigration Removal Centres' or other facilities. The programme will inform, hear from those who have experienced or are currently facing detention, and teach how we can organise in Merseyside. The activities will culminate in a party taking place Saturday 1 December, celebrating resistance and activism across the UK.

The gallery space displays testimonies from experts-by-experience as well as documentaries giving historical context to the struggle against Immigration Detention. There are resources on the reading table to explore over a cup of tea or coffee.

RWDP are also asking for donations of womxn's underwear and socks to distribute within Yarl's Wood. Please pick up a programme for full listings of events over the next four days.
